| 215.02/7318.16/01.06 | The effect of this amendment is that the rate of anti-dumping duty on hexagon nuts, of iron or steel (excluding dome nuts, nuts with non-metallic inserts, nuts of stainless steel, nuts identifiable for use solely or principally on aircraft and collared nuts), of a thread diameter of 6 mm or more but not exceeding 36 mm (excluding self-locking nuts of a thread diameter exceeding 10 mm), is increased from 36% of duty to 122,7%, as recommended in ITAC's Report No. 362. |
