REDUCTION IN THE RATE OF DUTY ON PENCIL LEADS

Synopsis

Pentel SA (Pty) Ltd applied for a reduction in the rate of duty on leads for pencils. As reason for the application, the applicant stated that pencil leads are not manufactured domestically and that the duty is a cost burden to industry and consumers. The Commission found that pencil leads are not produced in the SACU region and therefore recommended that the duty on pencil leads be reduced to free of duty.

Introduction

1. Pentel SA (Pty) Ltd applied for a reduction in the rate of duty on leads for pencils as there are no domestic manufacturers of pencil leads and as the current duty is a cost-burden to industry and consumers.

The tariff position

2. Pencil leads, black or coloured, are classifiable under tariff subheading 9609.20 as follows:

The application was published in the Government Gazette for comment by interested parties. No objections were received to a possible reduction in the rate of duty on pencil leads.

The industry and the market

3. The applicant is the largest domestic retailer of stationery writing products, of which refill pencil lead represents a significant portion of its total business

activities.

4. The estimated market share of all the distributors involved, as supplied by the applicant, is as follows:

5. Total Imports for 2007 amounted to R3 592 946.

Findings

6. The Commission found that pencil leads are not manufactured in the SACU region and that the current duty of 20% ad valorem has a cost-raising effect on industry and consumers.

Recommendation

7. In the light of the foregoing, the Commission recommends that the rate of duty on pencil leads classifiable under tariff subheading 9609.20, be reduced to free of duty.
